I think this must have been the moment when the full realization came to me that you had an innately violent side to you.

It was reported in the Daily Camera on July 18 and September 30, 1997, also in the Globe on July 28 that navy-blue pillings or fuzzy balls had been found on the long Johns leggings JonBenet was wearing the night she was murdered. Apparently, Boulder Police did get John Ramsey's navy-blue bathrobe checked to see if it could have been the source of those fuzzy balls but it was ruled out. But I doubt they have ever checked out the navy-blue sweater I handed over to them.

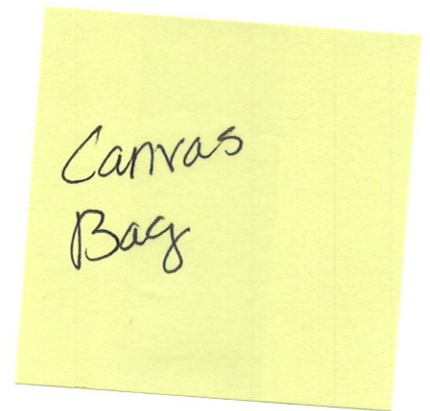

This is a close-up picture of that same photograph, but something struck me when looking at this photograph. And again, it is something that detectives look for, observation of things that look out of place. In this particular photograph, there is a dust ruffle on the bed, on the foot of the bed, that appears to have been disturbed. This dust ruffle goes all the way around the bed; and in this particular photograph, you can see the dust ruffle where it is tucked under. And also, at the foot of the bed, you can see where the dust ruffle is tucked under. And yet, one portion of the dust ruffle on the foot of the bed is out. And this close-up shows it very clearly. Something disturbed that dust ruffle.

Also in this room, there are drawers which are open. None of the other rooms in the house have any drawers open, but in this particular room they are opened. Something has been disturbed in that room.

Also in this room, a very significant clue left by our killer is a rope. The evidence invoice indicates that this rope was turned in, that it was found in a sack. I have no picture of the sack, but I have a picture of the rope.

The Ramseys, when questioned, know nothing about this rope. They say that it was not in that bedroom. It is out of place also. There is no other rope found in that house, and yet in the quest bedroom, right directly adjacent to JonBenet's room, there is a rope that is found that is unexplained.

Also, it said it was in a sack. And there are lab reports which indicate that small pieces of brown paper sack material were found in the vacuumings of JonBenet's bed and also in the body bag that was used to transport JonBenet's body.

This is from your deposition where you admit to having been a rock climber who because of this was familiar with knots. However, you did try to add that knot tying was not your strong point. Now come on Chris, that's just another of your lies isn't it?

You were already planning at least a sexual attack on a little girl even back then and I imagine you had already decided too that the little girl was going to be JonBenet. And I said "Yes". What a terrible, terrible decision that was. And to think I made it. Even though it was in all innocence. How was I to know then what terrible monstrous thoughts were in your mind?

During SUSAN - CHECK WHICH ONE Boulder police showed John a photo CBI had taken of the flashlight during one of his police interviews. John didn't think it was his flashlight because, he said, his flashlight was new and the one in the photo looked "dirty". Later Boulder Police released the story that what looked like dirt was actually the "remnants of fingerprinting chemicals" that CBI had used. But I believe what Boulder Police were saying about the discoloration was not accurate. I believe the discoloration was where, due to constant handling, the black metal coating had worn away from the barrel of that flashlight revealing the silver grayish metal color underneath. For that reason I believe that particular flashlight was mine and not John Ramsey's as Boulder Police are trying to have people believe

One strange thing that we didn't discover until the day after Christmas it was found that the outdoor light over the entrance to the main residence, which normally came on automatically every evening and were always on after dark, was out. A close inspection revealed that someone had actually disconnected the light globe from the socket. It was clear that the light at Dakota had clearly been put out deliberately by someone unknown for the night of December 25.

The most obvious culprit in all our minds was that it had to have been you, Chris because by this time your behaviour had begun to alarm us all.

I later found out that the outdoor safety light at the Ramsey house was also found to be out the day after the murder. Apparently, the globe to this light had also been removed. Looks to me like you might have been the person responsible for both these actions.

A. This is the other bat that was pointed out near the north window where there was some disturbance. This bat had a fiber attached to it that -- that was consistent with the fibers in the carpet in the basement where the body was found.

Q. Outside the wine cellar door?

A. Yes. Outside the wine cellar door. And this is a close-up of that bat laying in that position. This is in an area where the children do not play, and yet there was a bat there.

Q. And it is right there in the area of the north window where you found what you believe was evidence suggesting that someone may have attempted entry in that window?

A. Yes. Attempted entry into there. And it is also in a close proximity of the butler door, and I will be getting into that very shortly.

The butler door, and we will talk about that, the butler door in the Ramsey home -- and this is a diagram of the first floor. The butler door is located on the north side of the Ramsey home. The window that we described is located right directly below this powder room here. And the bat was located directly adjacent and north of this entryway on the outside. This is the butler door.

I know you would have worn gloves the night of the murder so I guess there is no point in testing the bat for your DNA. But I've often worried that if it did get tested, they might find Rick's DNA on it. I think though that Rick had a better alibi than you.
