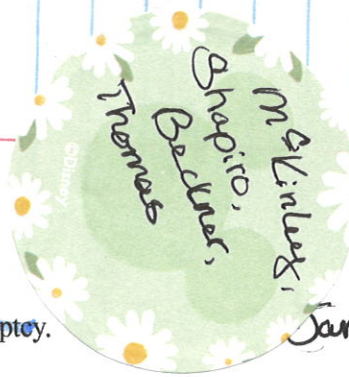

It was over a year since I had kicked you out and I felt I had no reason that would be believable to you as to why I should not let you stay, especially as you had said it was only going to be for a week. So I agreed to your coming and staying that time. And apparently it was true, you did have that new job you said you had lined up because a week later you were packing up getting ready to leave Dakota again. But before you left though, you gave me box of your belongings and asked if I could store them while you were away in New Orleans. Do you remember that Chris? I said yes and put the box up in the attic. I was rather intrigued as to what was in the box but I didn't ask at the time. I just made a mental note to take a look inside it once you were safely on your way to New Orleans. When I did eventually open it I was to discover something absolutely fascinating, which will discuss in Chapter 14 Letter to the Journalist.

Now this might seem a bit strange and it is. It just so happens that for two months Glenn Meyer, the man who was boarding in the Barnhill's basement at the time of the murder was staying at Dakota in one of the empty rooms. I had taken the poor man in because I could see he was in failing health. Meyer was living at Dakota the day you came back there to begin your week's stay before leaving for New Orleans. Now what was even stranger was that the minute you walked the door Glenn Meyer yelled out "That's him! That's the man I saw outside the Ramsey house on Christmas Day!" I couldn't believe my ears.

On September 15 1998 the grand jury was convened and neither you nor I were required to appear. The proceedings were to drag on for 13 months. Pretty much all of this time you were down in New Orleans. Away from me.

Nevertheless, I did hear from you not long after the grand jury had started running. You called me from New Orleans. You told me that your father had found out you were a suspect in the murder of JonBenet and that he had asked you if you had killed JonBenet Ramsey?

Now I don't understand why you were so all of a sudden bothered by this, Chris. I mean you had told Jeff Shapiro that your parents found out that you were a suspect when they read that in the article Dan Glick wrote for Newsweek in 1997.

Wolf has had enough. The accusations, Wolf says, have tormented his Midwestern parents, a retired couple who found out their son was a suspect while reading Newsweek in 1997.
